- Top 1-3 Areas of Concern and Why (Based on Community, Family, and School Input):
  - Kindergarten Readiness, students are not K ready after preschool. We have an increase in students with special needs who are non verbal and have behavior issues.
  - Chronic Absenteeism, 34% of Dayton Students have been identified as chronically absent according to ABC data.
  - Engaging communities and families will support and promote student interest while providing more resources and opportunities.
