### How Are Students Doing On The Path To A Successful Life?

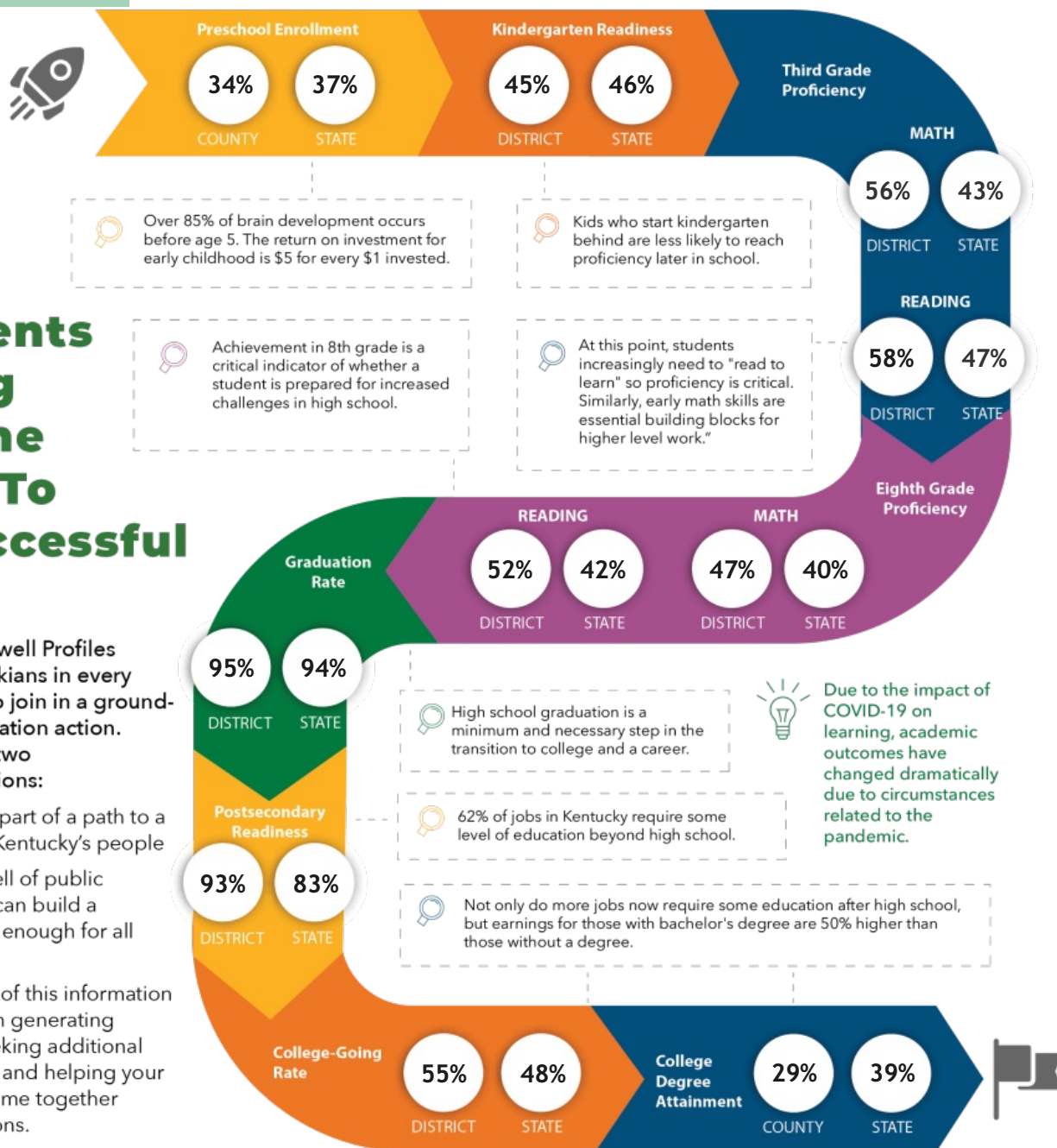
The Groundswell Profiles invite Kentuckians in every community to join in a groundswell of education action.

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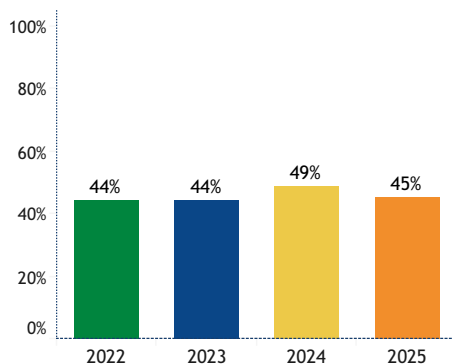

### HOW HAVE STUDENT RESULTS CHANGED IN RECENT YEARS?

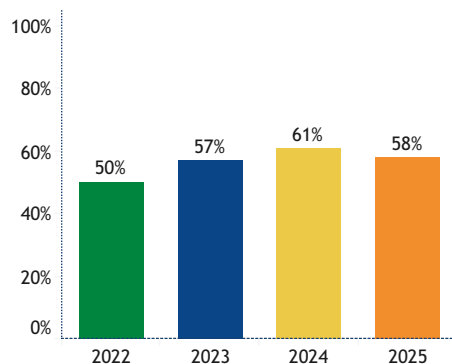

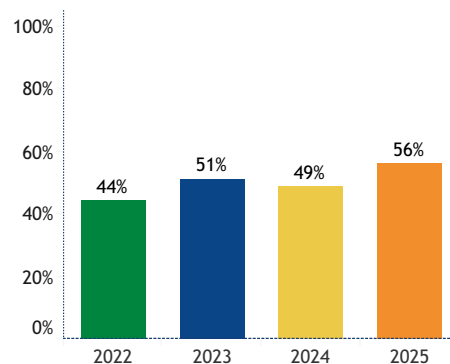

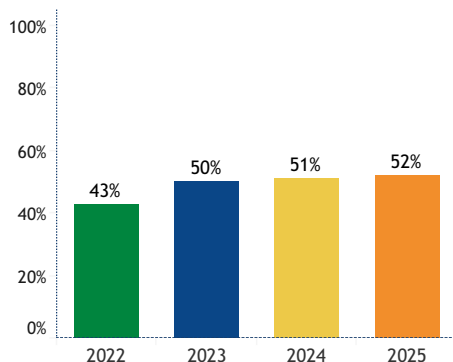
**Grade 3  
Reading Proficiency**



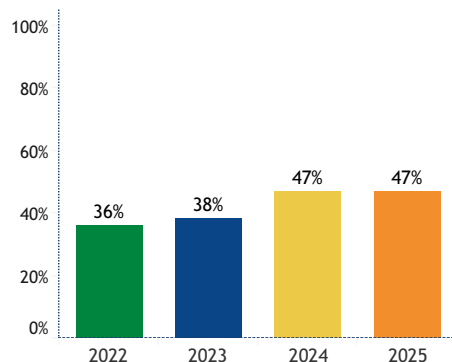
**Grade 3  
Math Proficiency**



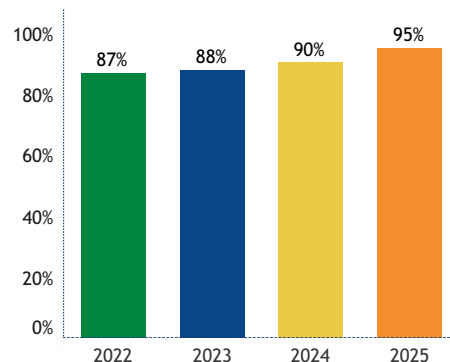
**Grade 8

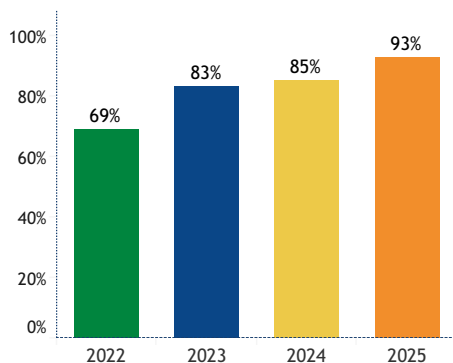

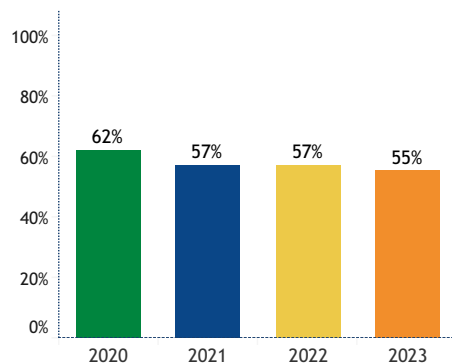
**Four-Year High  
School Graduation Rate**



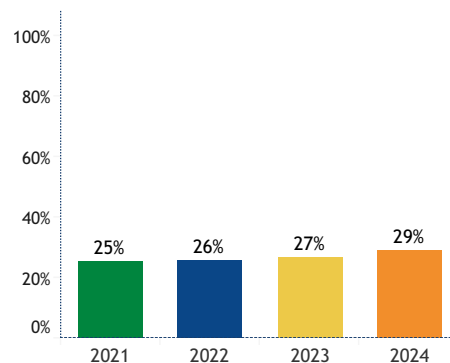
