### About the KY Collaborative:

Engaged communities- with families at the center- are vital to improving student and school outcomes. The Kentucky Collaborative for Families and Schools was created to build and sustain engagement, training, and resources for Kentucky families and educators in this critical work.

This Collaborative is being led by the Prichard Committee. There are 3 Regional Family Engagement Centers partnering on this work through local implementation of family engagement best practices and trainings. These Regional Centers are: Children, Inc., National Center for Families Learning, and Partners for Education at Berea College. The Kentucky Department of Education is also a vital partner in this work as we develop and sustain strong, productive relationships among schools, families, and community organizations so that children thrive developmentally and academically statewide.

#### What is the KY Collaborative Advisory Council?

This Council is parent-majority with approximately 40 members total. This Council is a diverse group of family representatives, school administrators, teachers, other education professionals and leaders in Kentucky, and representatives from businesses and community agencies. The purpose of the council is to:

- Provide guidance and feedback on activities to include priorities for the work, program barriers and policies to address, and types of trainings to offer
- Help identify needs for family engagement and strategies that strengthen the partnership between families and schools
- Promote parent and family voice in state policies affecting students from birth through college and career readiness
- Help with short-term sub-committee work around specific family engagement topics
- Support and mobilize a statewide family engagement network of families, practitioners, researchers, and policymakers
- Cultivate and strengthen leadership and communication skills
