


## Q1 How many children live in your household?



## Q2 What age(s) are your children? (select all that apply)





# Q4 What type of child care arrangement did your family typically use prior to the COVID-19 pandemic? (check all that apply)





# Q5 Is the child care provider you primarily used prior to the COVID-19 pandemic currently closed?





# Q6 If your child care program is currently closed, do they have a planned date of reopening?





# Q7 If your children have been home with you, are you using or did you use any of these resources? (check all that apply)











# Q12 Will you send your child back to the same child care arrangement as soon as they reopen?







# Q15 What could a child care provider do to make you more comfortable about sending your children back into care?










# Q19 Would you be interested in providing feedback directly to our survey partners about the impact the COVID-19 pandemic has had on you and your family?









## Q21 What county do you live in?















## Q23 Are you a recipient of support from the Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP)?



## Q24 Are you of Hispanic or Latinx origin?


